



MICHIANA DOWN SYNDROME

Marilyn Casper Academic Scholarship

One \$1000 academic scholarship a year may be awarded to a student with Down syndrome who is pursuing post-secondary education, technical or job training classes, or enrichment classes which teach independent living or life skills. To be eligible for this scholarship, the student with Down syndrome must be a member of the Michiana Down Syndrome Family Support and Advocacy Group. This grant is not based on need.

Scholarship requests must include:

- Student's name, address, phone number, and email if applicable
- Name, address, and phone number of academic institution
- Official high school transcript or copy of certificate or diploma
- Proof of enrollment in the program of study
- Description of program of study
- List of courses and course fees they wish the scholarship to cover
- Current transcript if applicant has completed courses
- Letter which describes why the applicant feels they should receive the grant
- Postmarked no later than May 1st.
